  - 2. The project, \$122,546.54 of which was awarded for Lakeview, has been awarded to Twin Lakes Quarry as the contractor and will take 60 WORKING days. The projected start date will be Sept. 1 at the latest.
  - 3. Twin Lakes Quarry is responsible for notifying areas affected by the project. However, they will notify us two weeks ahead of the actual date of construction so we can do some preliminary notification if we desire.
- B. City Hall A/C – Complete
  - 1. The unit has been installed and is working and hopefully will reduce the electrical bill. The A/C in the Civic Center has been replaced with a programmable thermostat in order to allow control over temps when not in use and to keep others from changing the settings.
