**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT HUNTER REQUIREMENTS FOR URBAN DEER HUNTS HELD IN THE CITY OF LAKEVIEW, BAXTER COUNTY, ARKANSAS.**


**WHEREAS**, an ordinance providing for a deer hunt (bow only) for the City of Lakeview, Baxter County, Arkansas was passed and adopted and;

**WHEREAS**, said adoption was presented to the electors of the City of Lakeview, Baxter County, Arkansas for concurrence and;

**WHEREAS**, the electors approved adoption by vote in the General Election specified;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the attached rules and regulations are adopted to cover the hunt.

## HUNTER RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Take and pass the international Bowhunter Education Course.
- Attend the urban hunt orientation
- Pass a shooting proficiency test, i.e three (3) consecutive hunting arrows shot from a hunting bow held at full draw by only the archer's muscles. All three (3) arrows must hit within or cut the line of the heart/lung area of a life-size deer target at a distance set by the test administrator (up to 20 yards).
- Pay a \$40.00 annual confirmation fee, which includes membership in the Arkansas Bowhunters Association, for liability insurance purposes.
- Posses a valid Arkansas (resident or non-resident) archery big game license. Hunters must be at least 16 years of age.
- Posses a valid urban Bowhunting Permit (issued at hunter orientation).
- Use a longbow, recurve or compound bow with at least a 40-pound pull and broadheads at least 7/8-inch wide (mechanicals ok). Special considerations will be made for disabled hunters in wheelchairs.
- Hunt without the use of string locks.
- Possess written permission from property owner if hunting on private property.
- Keep all bows cased to and from stands.
- Shoot from stands only (no walking, stalking or ground blinds).
- Hunt from stands that are at least 10 feet above the ground.
- Hunt 50 yards off designated trails or parks.
- Hunt at least 50 yards from any occupied dwelling without written permission.
- Bag or cover harvested animals from sight before removing. Every effort should also be made to remove and properly dispose of eviscerate if field dressing is done.
- Remove harvested animals during daylight if at all possible.
- Display the vehicle permit in full view on the dashboard of their vehicle and carry the approved permit.
- Donate their first deer to Arkansas Hunters feeding the Hungry (A 501C-3 charitable organization).**
