- A. Bull Shoals Urban Bow Hunter Association re 2015 Hunt
  - 1. Mayor Behling introduced Bill Craker , the President of the Bull Shoals Urban Bow Hunters Association, to address Council and those present regarding the change from the Urban Bow Hunt in Bull Shoals and Lakeview being regulated by the State and the National Bowhunters Association to Bull Shoals Urban Bow Hunters Association.
    - a. Proficiency of the hunters will be tested in a more realistic situation, namely from an elevated stand, minimum age of a hunter will be 12 years old and under supervision of an adult over 21, crossbows will be allowed from an elevated stand only with same testing as other hunters.

- b. Ground blinds will be allowed for physically challenged hunters with written permission obtained from the landowner and the board of directors. Wounded Warriors may be contacted in the future regarding this specific allowance.
2. After questions were answered by Mr. Craker, Mayor Behling asked if Council approved of the change from Game & Fish open urban bow hunt to the closed urban bow hunt proposed by Bull Shoals Urban Bow Hunters Association met their approval.
  - a. Council agreed to the change to the closed bow hunt.
