# BUS SAFETY AND DISCIPLINE

#### SAFETY TIPS FOR SCHOOL BUS RIDERS

- 1. ALWAYS remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- 2. ALWAYS watch your step and utilize the handrail when loading and unloading
- 3. ALWAYS wait for the driver to motion you across the roadways provided you must cross the roadway. ALWAYS cross in front of the bus
- 4. ALWAYS watch for the snagging of drawstrings and straps on book bags as you unload from the bus.
- 5. ALWAYS be aware of the danger zone (The area 10 feet all of the way around the bus). Take 10 giant steps away from the bus. DO NOT proceed back to the bus unless the driver has given you permission & is aware that you are doing so.
- 6. ALWAYS keep the aisle of the bus clear of your feet, books, lunch box, & book bag.
- 7. ALWAYS get on and off the bus in a single file. NO pushing or horseplay.
- 8. NEVER put your head, arms or ANYTHING out of the window.
- 9. NEVER throw things inside or outside the bus.
- 10. ALWAYS obey the school bus driver.
- 11. NEVER walk behind or along the side of the bus.
- 12. If you drop something near the bus, TELL THE DRIVER. NEVER try to pick it up because the driver may not be able to see you. NEVER crawl under a bus!
- 13. ALWAYS face forward when riding the bus.

## 14. When talking, TALK IN A SOFT TONE OF VOICE. Always be aware of the noise level.

### **BUS DISCIPLINE**

All Offenses will be handled through the recommended school discipline policies with the exception of the following occurring on school buses. Any student suspended from riding a bus is suspended from ALL district buses with the exception of special school related activities.

#### EXAMPLES OF OFFENSES AND ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN ARE:

#### LEVEL 1 (Minor Offenses)

Failure to comply

Chewing gum

Noisy or annoying behavior Out of seat or out in aisle

Turned around in seat Rudeness, improper language Eating or Drinking No bus pass Improper boarding/departing Unauthorized transportation Bringing objectionable objects

Horse-play, light pushing Any body part out of bus window

Throwing Objects

Littering

ACTIONS: 1st Offense - warning 2nd Offense - 1 day bus sus

2nd Offense - 1 day bus suspension 3rd Offense - 1 to 10 day bus suspension 4th Offense - Administrative Discretion

#### LEVEL 2 (Serious Offenses that directly affect others)

Rough PlaySpittingFightingProfanityGetting on any bus when riding privilege has been suspendedDamage to propertyDefiance

ACTIONS: 1st Offense - 1 day bus suspension 2nd Offense - 1 to 10 day bus suspension 3rd Offense - 1 to 3 day school suspension 4th Offense - Administrative Discretion

#### LEVEL 3 (Severe Offense)

Public Indecency Drugs, Alcohol, tobacco Sexual Harassment Possession of weapon

Level 3 offenses are ZERO tolerance items, which could result in 1 to 3 day school suspension combined with bus suspension for the remainder of the school year

Bringing dangerous objects Theft or dishonesty

Refusal to obey driver
