Friendly Tips from Mountain Home School District Department of Transportation

MH Transportation wants your student to have an awesome school year. The following bus rider tips will help them get started:

- Always be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early.
- ➤ Parents of younger students (KG, NWH, and Hackler) should be visible for the driver to see at the time of loading and drop-off.
- > Students should be 10 feet from the bus loading area at the bus stop.
- When crossing the road, wait on the driver to signal.
- ➤ Parents are encouraged to have their children keep the same routine on the bus with limited changes to drop off destinations especially earlier in the year. All bus passes must be approved and written by the school office. Bus notes written by parents should have a descriptive address on them so the school official can transfer it to the pass. Many times riders do not know exact addresses.
- ➤ The first couple days of school are typically a little longer due to teachers, students, and drivers acclimating schedules, so students may get home a few minutes later than normal.
- > Our bus route number is the single number on the white sign, listed on the side of the bus.
- Bus rider paperwork will come home with the student the second week of school.
