FOCUS MOUNTAIN HOME - ACTIVITY UPDATE

Bo Gregory, Director of Economic Development:

- Two more sites and two more buildings sent to State Site Selection database for upload. Each of our new sites
 have had new viewers since we have added them (this means more people know we have available property
 and we have an active economic development program).
- Two visits from our Arkansas ED team out of Little Rock, including Katherine Holmstrom, Steve sparks, and
 Steve Jones. One visit was to meet with a local industry to see if there were available State incentives to help
 them upgrade machinery. The other was to measure and tour an available facility for familiarization.
- Met with a local business who is Beta testing a solar product and included State involvement. The early visit
 from State personel will hopefully streamline their assistance when the company is ready to bring the product to market and hopefully expand employment.
- Working with FOCUS investor American Stichco to find an alternative use for material they frequently receive
 but is not an element of their production. This is high quality material and American Stichco is very interested
 in keeping it out of our landfill.
- Retention and Expansion committee met again to continue to build out our geospatial footprint through the
 capture of additional data points. These data points are important to help assure our ability to answer quickly
 and accurately questions about our local economy, available sites/buildings, and workforce. We are also
 exploring the creation of a number of sub-committees to address needs of specific sectors of our economy.
- Attended Integrity First Bank's monthly meeting as a guest speaker. The discussion included a broad discussion of the economic development needs of Mountain Home and the actions we have taken to address those needs.
- Launch of new Chamber website with new Economic Development section. Advanced demographic data and building listings to name just a few additions.
- Commercial broker visited Mountain Home on May 8th, inquiring about space for a retail fashion store.
- Working with City of Mountain Home to add additional information capture to the City's Occupation License
 Application. Much of the information/data points we are mining to complete the statistical picture of Mountain Home can be captured from new business when they fill out this form.
