**I Call to Order – 7 PM**

**III APPROVAL –**

***January Council Meeting***

- A. Ald. Manley moved to accept minutes as presented.
- B. Ald. K. Barton 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.
- C. Motion carried

***January Financials***

- B. Motion seconded by Ald. Manley

**IV. Police Report**

- A. Mayor Behling stated that the January report was being presented and asked if there were any questions concerning the report, none asked. The Report is on file for public review.

**Building Inspector Report**

- A. Mayor Behling stated that the report 1/11/16 to 2/10/16 was being presented and asked if there were any questions concerning the report, none asked. The Report is on file for public review.

**V. OLD BUSINESS:**

- A. Street Survey
  - 1. Mayor Behling stated the report could possibly be presented hopefully to Council at the March meeting. Until the report is delivered it will continue to be scheduled as old business.
- B. Ordinance 16-01 – Inter-local Coop. Agreement – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading
  - 1. Mayor Behling stated the Ordinance could be read completely or by title only.
    - a. Ald. Newell made a motion that the Ordinance 16-01 be read by title only, seconded by Ald. Svehla, motion approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.
    - b. Mayor Behling then read Ordinance 16-01 by title only. The March Council Meeting will be the third and final reading before approval.
- C. Discussion on investigating future sewer system
  - 1. Mayor Behling began the discussion with a list of things which need to be ascertained.
    - a. Will Lakeview have an independent system or work with Bull Shoals as a regional system.
    - b. Ultimate service for sewers: How much city? How much county?
    - c. Funding available to cover studies & engineering, secondly construction?
    - d. Can installation costs be assessed back to property owners as a special assessment?  
If so, how is it collected?
    - e. Can past studies be used?
  - 2. Ald. K. Barton asked about possibly including water along with the sewer due to concern regarding possible drought. Then making a priority of a sewer system for the business area on Hwy 178.

3. Ald. Manley stated after attending the Fall Conference she was concerned about EPA involvement and actually dictating what the City must accomplish.
4. Mayor Behling stated that if there were any other items of concern to address to be sure to send him an email.

D. Sound System

1. Mayor Behling stated that he had received an update on cost of the sound system from Brad's, however, the mics included were the large ones and he had requested the "button" style mic, which when discussed with the rep were supposed to be a small increase, but the figure received was twice the original quotation.
2. Ald. Galvan stated she might be able to contact another company regarding a bid on the system. Mayor Behling stated at this time Brad's has been the only company that has submitted a bid for the sound system and the only company that has responded to numerous request over the years.

**VI. NEW BUSINESS:**

A. Sale of old P.D. Camera to Gassville

1. Mayor Behling stated that the old camera from the Charger, which had been replaced with a newer one had been sitting in the property room of the P.D. and in conversation Chief Hotchkiss ascertained that the P.D. of Gassville would like to purchase the old camera for its use. Gassville has offered \$1500.00 for the camera and it seemed logical to accept the offer rather than allow it to collect dust. Mayor Behling asked for approval of the Council to sell the camera.
  - a. Ald. K. Barton made a motion to sell the camera to Gassville, seconded by Ald. Svehla and approved by the Council with 5 Yeas and 0 Nays.

**VII. Items from the Floor**

- A. Melissa Baker from the Bull Shoals/White River Chamber of Commerce addressed Council and the audience regarding the Gaston's Chef Night which will be March 2, 2016. Proceeds from the purchase of the ticket (50%) will be donated to the Bull Shoals Food Pantry. Shelf food items brought to the dinner would also be donated to the food pantry.
  1. She also stated that there will be the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade and Fall festival, which used to be celebrated years ago. Any other suggestions will be considered to help promote the area.
