- A. Mayor Behling stated that the report 2/7/16 to 3/6/16 was being presented and asked if there were any questions concerning the report, none asked. The Report is on file for public review.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Ordinance 16-01 – Inter-local Coop. Agreement – 3rd Reading
 - 1. Mayor Behling stated the Ordinance could be read completely or by title only.
 - a. Ald. Svehla made a motion that the Ordinance 16-01 be read by title only, seconded by Ald. Manley, motion approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.
 - b. Mayor Behling then read Ordinance 16-01 by title only; then asked for a motion to adopt Ordinance 16-01.
 - c. Ald. K. Barton made a motion to adopt Ordinance 16-01, Ald. Svehla 2nd the motion, motion approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.
- B. Street Survey
 - 1. Mayor Behling stated the report could possibly be presented hopefully to Council at the April meeting. Until the report is delivered it will continue to be scheduled as old business.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Resolution 16-02 – Adoption Hazard Mitigation Plan
 - 1. Mayor Behling stated that the Resolution was necessitated in order to receive disaster support from FEMA. Ald. Manley read the Resolution due to the issues Mayor Behling was having with a cold and then asked for a motion to adopt the Resolution.
 - a. Ald. Svehla made a motion adopt Resolution 16-02, seconded by Ald. Galvan and approved by the Council with 5 Yeas and 0 Nays.
- B. Mayor Behling introduced Ald. K. Barton to bring forward a suggestion that the City purchase copies of the Declaration of Independence, Constitution and the Bill of Rights to be

displayed in the Lloyd Travis Municipal Center. Copies of the posters and description of size and mounting as presented on-line were presented to Council for evaluation.

1. After discussion of the items it was decided to order these items for display.

VII. Items from the Floor

- A. Judy Behling asked if there were results of the deer hunt this past Fall/Winter. Mayor Behling brought the paperwork received from Ralph Meeker from the State Fish and Game and stated that there was a total of 71 deer harvested by the bowhunters. The total statewide from the other in-city deer hunts was 1,052.
- B. Joe Lauritson who is a resident on Ridgewood brought up the issue with upkeep of vacant properties and those of part time residents. If the City receives notification, or if officers make note of neglect or Ordinance violations then Maynard Gadway, the City's Ordinance Control Officer will address the situation. Mr. Lauritson stated that he would rake the leaves in a lot next to him and burn the leaves, which of course would make Mr. Lauritson liable for any damage done to his neighbor's property.
- C. The Bull Shoals White River Chamber of Commerce is providing plants for city beautification in Bull Shoals and Lakeview. Carl Hill, the Street Supervisor will be attending the meeting and make the decisions as to where to plant.
