




















Outstanding Seniors Kim Stone and Tony Gilbert




Andrea Smith and Bill Kerr earned recognition for being chosen to attend the Arkansas Governor's School, Andrea for instrumental music and Bill for natural




Outstanding Seniors Stacey Crawford and Phillip Crippen















Outstanding Seniors Lora Rhodes and Robert Justis


Outstanding Seniors Sammy Clark and Bruce Wilson


