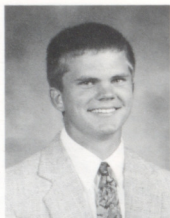

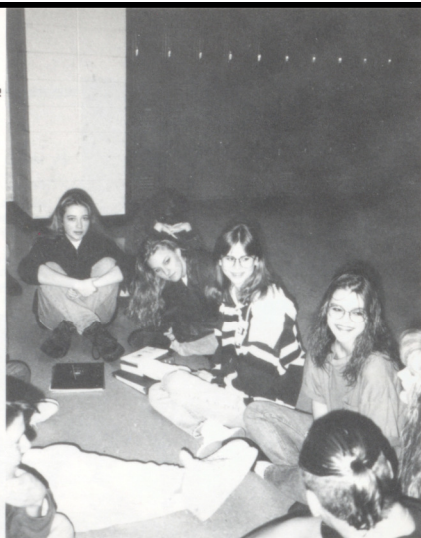

## Foreign Flair

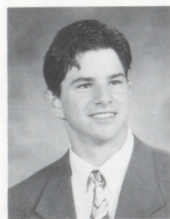
