III APPROVAL –

March Council Meeting

- A. Ald. Svehla moved to accept minutes as presented.

IV. Police Report

- A. Mayor Behling stated that the March report was being presented and asked if there were any questions concerning the report, none asked. The Report is on file for public review.

Building Inspector Report

- A. Mayor Behling stated that the report 3/8 to 4/9/17 was being presented and asked if there were any questions concerning the report, none asked. The Report is on file for public review.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Replacement for Ken Barton
 - 1. As stated by Mayor Behling, Council is responsible for replacement for officials that are unable to complete their term in office, which is this case. He stated also that Ald. Barton had approached his neighbor, David Taylor, about replacing himself.
 - a. Ald. Svehla made a motion that Council approve the appointment of David Taylor to complete the term of deceased Ald. Ken Barton
 - b. Ald. Galvan seconded the motion.
 - c. Motion approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.
 - 2. Mayor Behling had David Taylor step forward and swore him into office.
- B. Recorder-Treasurer Position
 - 1. The position is still open; but Council needs to recognize they are responsible to acquire a replacement for this office, which according to Recorder-Treasurer, Rebecca Barton, she would be leaving in one year for certain. There is a legal issue with this position that will be addressed at the time Council is presented Resolution 17-02.
- C. Street Projects
 - 1. Finally completed. Mayor Behling stated that he spoke with Ken Cotter regarding the delay in completion and that the City may delay payment to Marion County Pavement as well.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Resolution 17-02 – Amend Statutes re: Recorder-Treasurer
1. Mayor Behling read Resolution 17-02 completely, then stated the reason for presenting the Resolution 17-02 to Council which was concern regarding SB 138, Act 712, which can revoke a City's charter if they have 2 audit exceptions.
 2. Mayor Behling asked if there was a motion regarding Resolution 17-02
 - a. Ald. Svehla made a motion to approve Resolution 17-02, Ald. Hill made a 2nd to the motion.
 - b. Discussion was opened by Ald. Taylor who asked how the Resolution would be presented to State Legislation for approval.
 - c. Per Mayor Behling, the Resolution will be presented to the Resolution Committee at the 2017 League Conference; if approved the Municipal League will present it for Legislative action in the future. It was noted that a draft of the Resolution was presented to the small Cities & Towns Advisory Council on April 2nd and received favorable action and support. Mayor Behling will also seek similar action from the 2nd Class Cities Advisory Council.
 - d. Mayor Behling then requested a vote to approve Resolution 17-02, which was approved with 6 yeas and 0 nays.
- B. Mayor Behling asked if there were any more items of New Business
1. Ald. Hill asked about the number of tables allowed to be temporarily removed by citizens of Lakeview.
 2. Mayor Behling read the item regarding property assets available to citizens for loan; after much discussion it was ascertained that the number of tables/chairs would be limited per person and if there were any other activities at Lloyd Travis Municipal Center at the same date in which a certain number of tables and chairs were needed.

VII. Items from the Floor

- A. Grace Haggart addressed Council with her appreciation of the City's generosity with the loan of the tables and chairs to the Citizens of Lakeview.
