I Call to Order – 7:00 PM

- D. Mayor Behling stated that in reviewing budget items it was not necessary at this time to conduct a Budget Amendment, since revenues and expenses are within predicted levels. We will continue to monitor.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

A. Recorder-Treasurer Position

- 1. Mayor Behling reminded Council that Resolution 17-02 regarding a change in requirement of election of said position be changed to allowing cities of Class 2 to hire, will be presented to State Legislature by the Municipal League for legislative changes.
- 2. Mayor stated with presentation of an action plan presented at the June Council Meeting; he is proposing to form an Ad Hoc Committee to implement the plan and serve as the interview committee. He proposed Cncl Taylor as Chair; Cncl. Reubin and Cindy Stephens as members. Mayor Behling and the Recorder/Treasurer Barton will serve in an advisory capacity, but will not participate in the actual interview. The Mayor asked for Council approval.
 - a. Cncl. Newell made a motion to approve the Ad Hoc Committee, Cncl. Hill 2nd the motion and the motion was approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.

B. Storm Sirens

- 1. The Mayor stated that after obtaining the costs, lack of buyers for the old equipment and the drop in revenue from the City's Sales Tax of \$900.00 that it would be best to drop the possible purchase until more of an assessment of income was possible.

C. Review of Business Ordinances

1. Cncl. Taylor had created and presented to Council a rough draft of a proposed change regarding Businesses and the Ordinance connected to Businesses.
 - a. After reading and going over the suggested changes the Mayor and Alderman will make the suggested changes in wording, etc. to be presented the August Council Meeting.
- D. Cncl. Lindley stated that 9/12/17, the County Judge, Mickey Pendergrass, and the county Sheriff John Montgomery will be in attendance of a regional meeting at the Fire Station.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Appointment to P & Z Commission
 1. Mayor Behling stated that Mirta Van Gordon had stated that she would like to serve on the Commission. She owns an apartment complex here in Lakeview on Hwy 178.
 2. Cncl. Svehla made a motion to accept Ms. Van Gordon as a P&Z Commissioner, Ald. Hill 2nd the motion, the motion was approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.
- B. Chief Hotchkiss addressed Council concerning disposal of old equipment (laptop computer and stand). He wishes to donate it to the State Park Rangers locally in order to allow them to produce electronic tickets.
 1. Cncl. Newell made a motion to grant the disposal, Cncl. Lindley 2nd the motion and the motion was approved with 5 yeas and 0 nays.

VII. Items from the Floor

- A. Grace Haggard addressed Council with concerns about the proposed Business Ordinance when it specifically came to notification to business owners when their business is to be issued the yearly permit. This was to be ascertained as to days of notification prior to any tickets written for failure to comply. There was also discussion concerning food trucks and under what circumstances they were to be allowed.
