

**CITY OF LAKEVIEW
BAXTER COUNTY ARKANSAS
ORDINANCE 10-01**

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE ORDINANCES 5, 46, 60, 90-03, 91-02, 93-02 AND 94-03 CONCERNING THE OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF LAKEVIEW, BAXTER COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Lakeview is a Second Class City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to review and update ordinances currently in effect which may be outdated and/or no longer applicable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lakeview, Baxter County, Arkansas

SECTION I

ELECTED OFFICIALS

A. MAYOR. The Mayor shall be elected in accordance with Section 14-44-105 Arkansas State Statutes.

B. COUNCIL MEMBERS

- 1. There shall be six (6) Council Members elected in accordance with Section 14-44-103 Arkansas State Statutes.**
- 2. Council Members shall be elected to represent wards in accordance with Section 14-44-101) Arkansas State Statutes.**

C. RECORDER/TREASURER

- 1. It is in the best interests of the City of Lakeview that the offices of City Recorder and City Treasurer be combined in one position in accordance with Section 14-44-114 Arkansas State Statutes and hereinafter shall be known as Recorder/Treasurer for the City.**
- 2. Recorder/Treasurer shall be elected in accordance with Section 14-44-115 Arkansas State Statutes.**
- 3. The duties and office hours of the Recorder/Treasurer shall be as directed by the Lakeview City Council.**
- 4. The Recorder/Treasurer shall be entitled to five (5) days per calendar year as paid vacation.**

SECTION II

REGULATIONS FOR ALL CITY OFFICERS

A. OATH OF CITY OFFICERS. Every officer of the City shall take the Oath of Office as prescribed in Section 14-42-106 Arkansas State Statutes.

B. SALARIES

1. All officers of the City shall receive such salaries as may be provided from time to time by the City Council by Resolution. No officer receiving compensation from the City shall be entitled to retain any portion of any fees collected by him/her for the performance of his/her duties as such officer in the absence of a specific law or ordinance to that effect.
2. Council Members shall be required to attend eighty percent (80%) of meetings, both regular and special, as called annually. Any Council Member failing to meet this requirement shall forfeit \$35.00 per meeting for each absence over the required percentage

C. VACANCIES. Vacancies of elective officials shall be filled in accordance with Sections 14-44-104, 14-44-106 or 14-44-116 Arkansas State Statutes as they pertain to specific offices.

SECTION III

SEVERABILITY- The invalidity or unconstitutionality of the provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any other section hereof, but same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV


EMERGENCY CLAUSE- This Ordinance being necessary to insure compliance with terms, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage.
