ATTENTION PARENTS, GRANDPARENTS AND GUARDIANS

The 2018-2019 school year is off and running. This announcement is to help our mornings to be less stressful and to make sure our students are safe and secure, which is our top priority. With that in mind, if you are dropping off your child before 7:30, no matter what grade they are in, please drop them off at the 3rd grade door in the 3rd & 4th grade car line area. We have a staff member to watch them until the 7:30 bell rings.

Please do not drop students off in 5th grade car line before 7:30. No staff member is there and that is a safety issue.

If you are dropping them off after 7:30, 3rd & 4th grade students will be dropped off in the 3rd & 4th grade car line. You can line up two by two until you get to the building and then it will be a single line only in the left hand lane. Please pull forward as far as possible, and we can load and unload 14 cars at one time. Always stay in the left hand lane.

If you are dropping off in the 5th grade area, do not have students exit the car until a Hackler staff member is present and the 7:30 bell has rung. Please stay in the left hand lane only. Do not ask cars to pull over so you can exit. This causes safety issues and our students' safety is our top priority. Please pull forward, but not past the traffic cone. Students can enter the building from two doors and will go to the gym or cafeteria to wait for the 7:50 bell to ring and head to class.

Remember that if your child arrives at 8:00, you will need to park, walk your student in, and fill out a tardy slip located in the front lobby.

Thank you for helping our school run effectively and efficiently by working together. We also appreciate Officer Joe's presence on our Hackler campus to help resolve any issues that arise.
