What is **Red Ribbon Week** all about? The National Partnership, formerly the **N**ational **F**ederation of **P**arents for Drug Free Youth, was established as a grassroots, nonprofit organization in 1980 by a handful of concerned and determined parents who were convinced they should begin to play a leadership role in drug prevention. The NFP provides drug awareness by sponsoring the annual National **Red Ribbon Campaign** (™). Since its beginning in 1985, the Red Ribbon has touched the lives of millions of people around the world in response to the murder of DEA Agent Enrique Camarena, angered parents and youth in communities across the country began wearing **Red Ribbons** as a symbol of their commitment to raise awareness of the killing and destruction caused by drugs in America. In 1988, NFP sponsored the first National **Red Ribbon Celebration**. Today, the **Red Ribbon** serves as a catalyst to mobilize communities to educate youth and encourage participation in drug prevention activities.

The themed days are as follows:

- ❖ Monday, October 22, is crazy sock day. "Sock it to Drugs"
- ❖ Tuesday, October 23, is wear bright colors.
"Our future is too bright for drugs."
- ❖ Wednesday, October 24, is hat day. "Hats off to being drug free"
- ❖ Thursday, October 25, is wear red day.



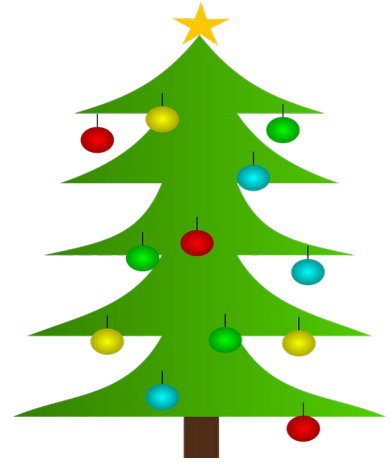

Cost is \$20. All proceeds go to help support our Bomber Wrestling team.

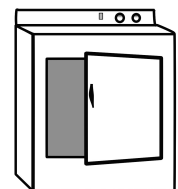
