Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year, Ozark Mountain School District is going to Provision 2. What this means for you and our students is that you will not be charged for our student meals. The district will cover that cost using Enhanced Student Achievement (ESA) Funds.

It is very important that you fill out the meal application and return it to the school as soon as possible. This is what is called our base year. That means we are using the numbers of free and reduced priced students to determine our percentages for federal reimbursement each month. Applications are to be completed as you normally would. Once our base year is set, you will not have to fill out applications again for at least three (3) years, possibly longer.

Ozark Mountain School District is also going to offer ala carte items to students in grades 5 – 12. Students who wish to purchase these items may do so as they come through the lunch line. They are to pay for the items at that time, or you may send money to be placed on their accounts in advance. Ala carte items may not be charged to their accounts. Also, any account with a negative balance carried over from previous years is to be paid in full before a student may purchase ala carte items. You may call the school to find out if your student has a negative balance at any time. I have listed the contact information for each campus below.
