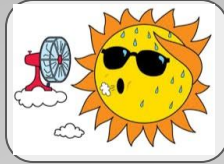


# 2019-2020 Hackler Newsletter

With that in mind, if you are dropping your child off before 7:30, no matter what grade they are in, please drop them off at the 3rd grade door in the 3rd & 4th grade car line area. We have a staff member to watch them until the 7:30 bell rings.

Please do not drop students off in 5th grade car line before 7:30. No staff member is there, and that is a safety issue.

## **HACKLER HAPPENINGS**

- Please communicate with your child about where they are to go after school. The best way to communicate this information to the teacher is through Dojo or the assignment book. Calls to the office for transportation should only be made in emergency situations. The office does not need to know how your child is going home if you have already communicated this to your child's teacher. This will help reduce interruptions during instructional time for the teachers and students.
- Lunch accounts should be paid weekly. If you want to know your child's balance, you can set up a [www.ezschoollpay.com](http://www.ezschoollpay.com) account. You can have the app email you when the balance gets below the amount that you set up within the app. You can also pay with a debit or credit card on this app. Call the school to get your child's 10 digit account number.
- It is very important that you fill out the first day packet information and return it to your child's homeroom teacher as soon as possible.
