# Scholarship Applicant Evaluation HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATION GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Students,

The competition is very tough, so our committee follows specific criteria when evaluating the scholarship applications. The following information is to give you an idea of what our committee looks for during the evaluation process. Award of scholarships is not guaranteed - scholarships will be awarded to applicants with the highest total points <u>based on availability of funds</u>. This application may be used for college bound students or for a vocational/technical training.

## **REQUIREMENTS/RESTRICTIONS:**

- Students must live in club service area: Bull Shoals, Flippin, Midway, Lakeview
- Must attend Flippin High School, Mountain Home High School, or be Home Schooled in the club service area
- Recipients are expected to work at our Rotary Club's annual pancake breakfast and attend Bull Shoals-Lakeview Rotary Club meeting award ceremony (with lunch!)
- Must be turned in to the Counselor by Wednesday, March 4, 2020
- Remember, Applications:
  - Must Be Typed, Must Be Neat, Must Be Complete.
  - Fill in ALL the blanks and Include all requested attachments

<u>Vocational/Technical Scholarships for our service area</u> will provide financial assistance to students who wish to enroll in an accredited vocational program at regional schools, such as the community colleges or technical trade schools leading to degrees or certifications in mechanics, electrical, welding, etc.

#### EVALUATION CRITERIA

#### 1. <u>Neatness and Completeness in Filling out the Form</u>

This may give an insight as to the applicant's ability to follow instructions and to a degree of the amount of self-discipline the applicant has achieved. **MUST BE TYPED & Complete!** 

#### 2. Grade Point Average and ACT Composite Score

Consider the degree of difficulty of each subject taken as well as the school which the student is attending. Example: An "A" in math would be more difficult to get than an "A" in Introduction to Theater. What classes were taken that would benefit the choice of field of study in college.

#### 3. Future plans and Goals in Life

Consider the personal letter (200-250 words), the family life of the applicant, what the applicant wants to do with his/her life. What has the applicant done with his/her life to this point? Consider the references and what was said about the applicant.

#### 4. Extracurricular Activities

Consider clubs, organizations, and volunteer hours outside the classroom. Does the applicant serve as an officer or on committees? Does the applicant volunteer service to the community?

# 5. Level of Financial Assistance Being Received

## NOTE: The more funding the applicant has, the lower the score.

- a. Has applicant received any grants or scholarships? Were they for one year only, are they renewable or on-going?
  - Is the applicant working during the school year and during the summer to assist in paying for school costs? Does it appear that the parents are able to assist or is the applicant more or less self-dependent?
