 - c. Community and volunteer activities (include how they benefited the community)
5. Two dated and signed letters of recommendation: (1) one from the school principal or counselor and (2) one from an employer or character reference (not from a relative). The letter should cover the applicant's ability, work habits, integrity and potential.
