

## Materials and Hardware:



Passenger Side Blinker Light



Driver Side Blinker Light

TTTT O O O O 3/8" x 1" Carriage Bolt with Flanged Nylock Nut

	<ol> <li>Adjust the tilt to its lowest position. This is to make room for the wire harness.</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Locate the flasher attached to the wire harness of the Pod.</li> <li>Remove the flasher from its plug.</li> <li>Note: The reason for removing the flasher is to allow the wire harness to be fed through the opening in the steering column illustrated in the next step.</li> </ol>
STEP 3	<ol> <li>Feed the wire harness through the opening shown here.</li> <li>Note: This step may require some assistance to direct the wire harness through the steering column from under the hood. Some of the plugs are a tight fit but, be assured, they will fit through the space shown here.</li> </ol>

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Installation Instruction: Blinker Assembly

<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>Take care to direct the wire harness through the dash panel frame as shown here.</li> <li>When you are satisfied with the route of your wire harness, plug the flasher back up to its receptacle.</li> <li>Note: This view is shown from the driver, under the fender well looking up at the dash.</li> </ol>
<image/>	<ol> <li>Locate the plug.</li> <li>Cut the two zip ties indicated by the smaller arrows.</li> <li>Note: This view is looking in from the hood access, toward the driver side of the machine.</li> </ol>
STEP 6	1. Remove looped plug to expose the receptacle.

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Installation Instruction: Blinker Assembly

STEP 7	<ol> <li>Insert the matching plug from the Blinker Pod to the existing wire harness plug.</li> <li>Make sure the plug is inserted all the way.</li> </ol>
STEP 8	<ol> <li>With a Phillips Head screwdriver, attach the pod to the steering column using the provided hardware.</li> <li>Get both screws started then adjust the pod for the desired position.</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>With zip-ties, secure the components of the wire harness back to the frame as shown here.</li> <li>Place the zip-ties in the location indicated or where it best suits you.</li> </ol>

Mahindra Rise.



	<ol> <li>Set the two piece bracket in place attaching to the outside, vertical tube of the brush guard as shown here.</li> </ol>
<image/>	<ol> <li>Align the bracket with the top tube and secure it with the provided 3/8 x 1" Carriage Bolt and Flanged Nylock Nut.</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>Locate the existing blinker plug located just behind the headlight.</li> <li>Pull the plug free from the cluster (it may or may not be necessary to cut the zip-ties holding the wire cluster).</li> <li>Note: This view is from the passenger side of the machine.</li> </ol>

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STEP 13	<ol> <li>Connect the blinker plug to the blinker light as shown here.</li> </ol>
<image/>	<ol> <li>Secure the plug to the headlight frame as shown here.</li> <li>Another <u>option</u> would be to drill a hole in the underside of the plastic to route the plug through.</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>To connect the horn, first locate the two wires designated for the horn, located in the machines wire harness. There is a black wire and a green (with white stripe) wire. They should have a small zip-tie holding them together. Pull these free from the bundle.</li> <li>Note: This view is looking in from the hood to the passenger side of the machine. The wires may be difficult to find, but be assured they are there.</li> </ol>



<image/>	<ol> <li>Located inside the horn package, there are two connector ends.</li> <li>Attach the connectors to the two wires located in the previous step as shown here.</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>Connect the two wires to the horn itself as shown here.</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>With a ½" socket, remove the self-threading bolt, indicated here.</li> <li>Retain the bolt, it will be used to mount the horn.</li> <li>Reminder: This view is still looking in from the hood access, toward the dash panel.</li> </ol>

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<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>Attach the mounting bracket to the horn (the bracket and nut are provided in the pre- packaged horn kit).</li> </ol>
<section-header></section-header>	<ol> <li>Mount the horn using the same bolt removed in STEP 18.</li> <li>Adjust to desired position and tighten the bolt.</li> </ol>
STEP 21	<ol> <li>Double check all connections and tighten all remaining loose bolts.</li> <li>Turn the key on and check to see that all blinkers and the horn are working properly.</li> </ol>
