Deadline: The completed application must be postmarked no later than January 1, 2021.

Audition/Interview: All applicants are required to attend an audition and interview on Sunday, January 24, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. at St. James United Methodist Church, located at 321 Pleasant Valley Drive, Little Rock in Little Rock. All must adhere to proper social distancing and wear masks except when singing. Church is thoroughly sanitized and cleaned.

The applicant will perform (from the classical genre) two selections of contrasting styles. It is requested that the applicants bring their own accompanists. If not able, please send music ahead for ACS accompanist.

Notification of scholarship recipient selection will be made as soon as possible after the audition/interview process and all other applicants will be notified of their status. The First Place \$1,000 and Second Place \$500 non-renewable scholarship awards will be made payable to the recipient to be used for college expenses.
