Arkansas: Cell phone law, § 27-51-1609

Cell, text messaging update: An act prohibiting use of handheld cell phones in school zones and highway work zones took effect Oct. 1, 2011. State law prohibits all motorists from using a mobile phone while in a school zone or passing a school building when children are present. The law prohibits both talking and texting while driving in those areas.

UPDATED ATHLETIC ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS

In response to increased numbers of community spread cases of COVID-19, and with student and spectator health in mind, Mountain Home Public Schools will now require students in grades K-9 to be accompanied by and sit with a parent or guardian during athletic events.

All students in grades 10-12 and student athletes in grades 7-9 with fall athletic passes may attend games without a parent or guardian and should sit in the designated student section.

The student section for football games is located on the track between the home bleachers and the scoreboard. Students sitting in this area are invited to bring lawn chairs and are required to practice social distancing.

The change will go into effect on Thursday, October 1 and will apply to all forthcoming district sporting events.

In addition to this change, extra vouchers for football games will no longer be available at the gates on game night. If a spectator arrives at the stadium without a voucher, he/she will not be permitted to enter. Vouchers are available at the MHHS athletic office through Thursday, October 1 at 4 p.m.. Those with fall student athletic passes and those with AAA passes will be permitted without vouchers, but all other spectators -- including school employees -- must have a voucher. Masks are still required for all spectators grades 3 and up and must be worn at all times.
