Mountain Home Public Schools has five state approved Alternative Method of Instruction (AMI) days, in case we have absences due to snow, flu, etc. The state department has allowed us to offer these assignments in lieu of making up these cancelled days at the end of the school year. If we were to cancel school, Dr. Jake Long, Superintendent of Schools, or his designee, will notify you through Connect 5 what AMI day we are on so you will know which assignment(s) to have your child complete. If you do not receive Connect 5 alerts, you may listen to KTLO or other local media for school cancellation(s).

NWH students will have a technology or a paper option. If you have access to a device and internet at home your child should choose the technology option, if not, he/she will need to do the paper option.

Your child MUST complete each day's activities for their attendance to be counted. Failure to do so will give your child an UNEXCUSED absence for that AMI day. If you have questions on an AMI day, you can reach your child's teacher via email or the Canvas Parent App.
