<u>Students:</u> This is a <u>required</u> performance. You will receive a <u>grade</u>. Please wear your Pinkston Band t-shirt & mask to the concert. Leave your case in your vehicle. Parents should drop you off in the HS Band parking lot, across from Hiram Shaddox, then drive around the building to park by Dunbar.

- All concerts will be live-streamed via the Mountain Home Bomber Bands Facebook page we strongly encourage family, friends, & community to watch online.
- Due to Covid and limited indoor seating, tickets for the concerts will be distributed directly to band members for use by parents & family members. This is based upon the size of each band & seating available in Dunbar to allow for social distancing:
  - Pinkston 7th Grade 4 tickets per band member
- Band members will be given their tickets in class.
- Tickets will <u>not</u> be replaced once issued (lost, end up in the laundry, eaten by the dog, etc.) band members need to make sure that tickets make it home to parents.
  - We will be unable to replace any tickets for any reason.
- Tickets are good for your child's concert ONLY. No one will be allowed to stay in Dunbar to watch the other concert. The auditorium must be cleared, air recycled, and public areas sanitized between concerts.
- Dunbar Auditorium will open 15 minutes prior to the scheduled concert time. Ticket holders
  must enter through the front glass doors of Dunbar; please social distance every other row is
  marked off and closed family members may sit together please allow at least 2 empty seats
  between other families in attendance MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES!
- Please do <u>not</u> attend if you are sick, have a fever, or Covid-related symptoms the concert will be live-streamed.
- Students have an assigned report time for their concert screening questions & temperature checks will take place when they report - please stay home if you are sick, have a fever, or Covid-related symptoms. An alternate performance assignment will be made for those under quarantine &/or in BVA.
- All students & audience members must leave Dunbar IMMEDIATELY after the conclusion of the concert. Please do not linger in the auditorium or lobby - band members should meet their family outside of Dunbar, in front of the high school main entrance, after performing.

Thank you for your understanding & cooperation to make this live concert possible! Encourage additional family members to live-stream.

Dear Parent/Guardian of a 6th grade girl:



All 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls will be screened for scoliosis on Wednesday February 24<sup>th</sup>. Scoliosis is a sideways curving of the spine, resembling an S-curve. Eighty-five percent of the time, scoliosis has no known cause and tends to run in families. This type of scoliosis first develops between the ages of 10 - 15 years and occurs more often in girls than boys. If scoliosis is detected early, treatment can be started and almost all of the curving is prevented.

The procedure for screening is a simple one in which the child's back is observed as he/she stands upright and bends forward. Students will be asked to expose their spinal area for the exam. Tops may be left around the neck, draping down to cover the front of the body. It is recommended that students wear a bra, sport bra or cami to lessen some of the anxiety associated with the procedure. The screening will be conducted in privacy with only the student and nurse present.

Any curvature or "back hump" that is noticed during the screening may indicate the need for further studies. If a problem is found, you will be notified. We will recommend that you take your child to a physician of your choice for an evaluation.

An Arkansas law was passed in August 1988 making scoliosis screening mandatory for all 6th grade girls. The only acceptable reason for exclusion from screening is if it is contrary to the parent or guardian's religious beliefs. This must be put in writing and handed to the examiner when the child is called to be screened. Phone calls will not be accepted. If your child is currently under treatment for a back problem by a medical doctor, please let us know that in writing.

ANY 6TH GRADE GIRL WHO IS ABSENT AT THE TIME OF SCREENING WILL BE CALLED TO THE OFFICE AT A LATER DATE FOR SCREENING.
