Ages 8 & under must swim one length of the pool unassisted.

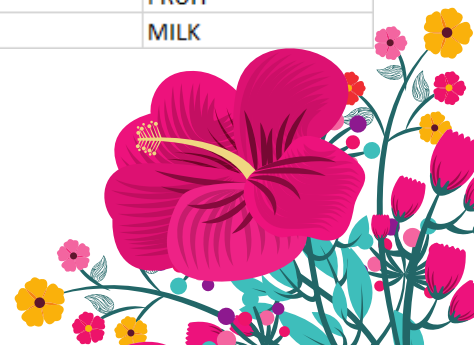

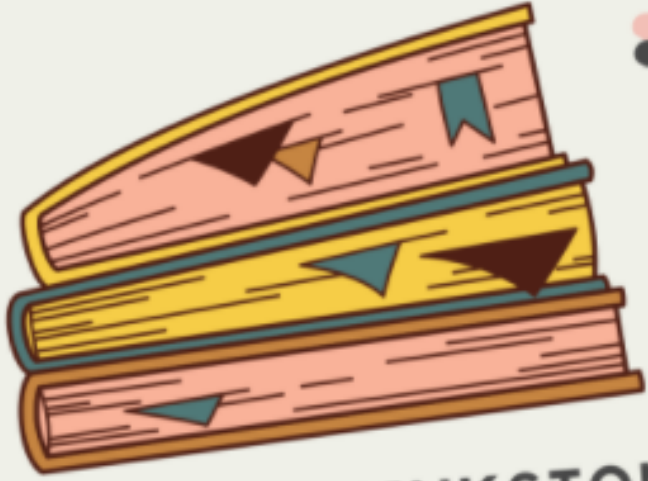
